**Scene: In the upper parking lot a car driven by a victim in insulin shock runs down a group of four teenagers**

**00:00 - First lifeguard enters scene**

**00:30 - Second lifeguard enters scene**

**01:00 - Rest of team enters scene**

**03:00 - Spinal #2 - goes unconscious non breathing**

**05:00 - Spinal #1 - goes pulse less**

**06:00 - Diabetic goes unc.**
